SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 306, L.D. 954, "An Act To Provide Equal Access to the Benefits of the Maine Food Sovereignty Act"


Amend the amendment in section 1 in §284 in the first indented paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Second," the following: 'pursuant to the authority granted to plantations by Title 30-A, section 7051,'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §284 in the first indented paragraph in the 4th line (page 1, line 18 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "municipality" the following: 'or plantation'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies the authority of plantations to adopt ordinances regarding direct producer-to-consumer transactions for food or food products.
