An outside reviewer must sign a written agreement with the commissioner not to be employed, directly or indirectly, by any applicant whose application was reviewed by that reviewer for at least 12 months from the date the review of the application is complete in connection to the proposal for which the applicant submitted the application.'

30 31 32	This amendment replaces the bill. It amends the conflict of interest provisions in the Department of Environmental Protection laws related to an outside reviewer of an application to specify that an outside reviewer is precluded from reviewing an application
