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### **SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the unanimous report of the committee, removes the requirement for the Department of Health and Human Services to convene a stakeholder group as part of the rule-making process to implement the new dental coverage requirements. It adds authority for the joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters and appropriations and financial affairs to report out legislation related to the 5-year implementation report from the department. It also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
