Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<b>Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §329, sub-§2-A,</b> as amended by PL 2011, c. 424, Pt. A, §3 and affected by Pt. E, §1, is repealed.
<b>Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §329, sub-§7, ¶A,</b> as amended by PL 2007, c. 440, §5, is repealed.
<b>Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §336, sub-§5,</b> as enacted by PL 2009, c. 383, §9, is repealed.
SUMMARY
This bill repeals the requirements for a certificate of need issued by the Department of Health and Human Services for the acquisition of major medical equipment.
