HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 747,  
L.D. 1009, "Resolve, To Create a Health Care Ombudsman Position To Serve in Maine's  
County Jails"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 20 in amendment) by  
striking out the following: ", who shall serve as chair,"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by inserting after subsection 16 the following:

'The Commissioner of Corrections or the commissioner's designee and the member  
representing the Maine Sheriffs' Association shall serve as cochairst of the working group.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that the Commissioner of Corrections or the commissioner's  
designee and the member representing the Maine Sheriffs' Association serve as cochairst of  
the working group established in Committee Amendment "A."
