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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 757, L.D. 1019, "An Act To Promote  
Transparent Emergency Management"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in subparagraph (13) in division (b) in the last line (page 1,  
line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~and up to 60 days after the state of  
emergency is terminated~~" and inserting the following: 'and up to 60 days after the state of  
emergency is terminated'

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Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

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'Sec. 2. 37-B MRSA §742, sub-§1, ¶F is enacted to read:

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F. An order issued by the Governor pursuant to this subsection following an emergency  
proclamation expires the soonest of:

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(1) Thirty days following issuance of the order;

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(2) The termination of the state of emergency by the Governor or the Legislature  
pursuant to section 743; and

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(3) The issuance of a different emergency proclamation by the Governor.'

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Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section  
number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, retains the language  
in current law that termination of residential electricity and water services may be  
suspended for up to 60 days after a state of emergency is terminated.

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
