COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 775, L.D. 1047, "An Act To Create an
10 Alternate Minimum Wage Applicable to Student Employees Who Are under 20 Years of
11 Age and to Employees Who Are under 18 Years of Age"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

13

'An Act To Create an Alternate Minimum Wage Applicable to Employees Who Are
14 under 18 Years of Age'

15

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.)
16 by striking out the following: "Student and minor" and inserting the following: 'Minor'

17

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 4
18 and 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "an employee who has not attained 20 years
19 of age and is a student at a secondary or postsecondary school and"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
21 number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the committee. This amendment removes
24 from the bill the language that allows an employer to pay an employee who has not attained
25 20 years of age and is a student at a secondary or postsecondary school a minimum hourly
26 wage of \$9.75.
