Hunt from an observation stand or blind overlooking salt, grain, fruit, nuts or other foods known to be attractive to deer. This prohibition does not apply to hunting from 21 an observation stand or blind overlooking: 22 23 (1) Standing crops; 24 (2) Foods that are left as a result of normal agricultural operations or as a result of a natural occurrence; or 25 (3) Bear bait that is placed at a bear hunting stand or blind in accordance with 26 27 section 11301, subsection 1. Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §11452, sub-§1-A is enacted to read: 28 1-A. Exception; disabled veteran. Subsection 1 does not apply to a disabled veteran 29 who has been issued a hunting license under section 10853, subsection 4. 30 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 31
