An Act To Permit the Conduct of Open Air Cremation at Designated Scattering Sites

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1408 is enacted to read:

§1408. Open air cremation

Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter, Title 13, chapter 83 or Title 22, section 707 to the contrary, a nonprofit corporation may conduct an open air cremation by pyre if the cremation is conducted on property owned or possessed by the corporation that is at least 20 acres in size. Only one open air cremation may be conducted at a time. The ashes constituting the remains of the deceased person who is cremated may be scattered on the property or otherwise disposed of pursuant to law. The board shall adopt routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A to carry out the purposes of this section.

12 SUMMARY

This bill allows a nonprofit corporation to conduct open air cremations by pyre if the cremation is conducted on property of at least 20 acres that is owned or possessed by the corporation, restricted to one cremation at a time. The bill allows the ashes to be scattered on the property or otherwise disposed of pursuant to law.
