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Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 7th to 9th lines (page 1, lines 7 to 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "The working group shall build on work completed by the working group that was convened pursuant to Public Law 2011, chapter 380, Part U to refine and further develop options."

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Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

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
