COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 377, L.D. 1114, "An Act To Require the State To Meet the Mandatory 55 Percent Contribution to Schools"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §15671, sub-§7, ¶B, as amended by PL 2021, c. 29, Pt. C, §1, is further amended by amending subparagraph (17) to read:

(17) For fiscal year 2021-22 and succeeding years, the target is ~~51.83%~~ 55%.'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
