1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §902, sub-§1-D** is enacted to read:

3 **1-D. Memorial to victims of COVID-19 pandemic.** Notwithstanding section 902-A,  
4 subsection 2, paragraph B, the commission may arrange for and oversee the development  
5 and installation in Capitol Park or the State House or its immediate grounds of a monument  
6 honoring the victims of the pandemic related to coronavirus disease 2019, or COVID-19.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill allows the State House and Capitol Park Commission to arrange for and  
9 oversee the development and installation of a monument honoring the victims of the  
10 pandemic related to coronavirus disease 2019, or COVID-19.
