This amendment strikes from 20 the bill Part A, which authorizes transport officers to transport persons in the custody of 21 the Department of Corrections and the county jails and regional jail, authorizes the use of 22 force by transport officers, prohibits the use of force, laser pointers and electronic weapons 23 against transport officers, corrections officers and corrections supervisors, allows private 24 persons to assist transport officers when directed to do so and requires mental health first 25 aid training for transport officers. 26

Expanding the list of those eligible for the death benefit will reduce the balance in the Maine Budget Stabilization Fund. The exact amount by fiscal year cannot be determined at this time and will depend on the number of eligible individuals who die in the line of duty.

Additional costs to the University of Maine System, Maine Maritime Academy and the Maine Community College System associated with expanding the list of officers that qualify for a tuition waiver can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
