2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§107 is enacted to read:
3 4 5	107. Firearm safety devices. Beginning January 1, 2022, sales of firearm safety devices. For purposes of this subsection, "firearm safety device" means, if specifically designed for securing firearms:
6	A. A safe or lockbox; or
7	B. A trigger or barrel lock.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill establishes a sales tax exemption for a safe, lockbox, trigger lock or barrel lock that is specifically designed for securing firearms.
