COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 854, L.D. 1176, "An Act To Improve
10 Fairness in Auto Insurance Claims"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
12 following:

13

'Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §2910-B is enacted to read:

§2910-B. Assessment of value of motor vehicle

15

If an insurer uses the value of a comparable motor vehicle to assess the value of a
16 damaged motor vehicle, the comparable motor vehicle used by the insurer must be in
17 Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island or New York
18 and the value of that comparable motor vehicle must be its value in Maine, New Hampshire,
19 Vermont, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island or New York to the extent comparable
20 vehicles are available in these states. An insurer may use a comparable motor vehicle in a
21 state not specified in this section only after determining that comparable motor vehicles are
22 not available in the states specified in this section.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
24 number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

26

This amendment clarifies the bill's provision regarding damaged vehicle value
27 assessment, providing that insurers are required to use comparable motor vehicles in the
28 designated states if available and are permitted to expand the search only after determining
29 that comparable motor vehicles in those states are not available.
