The Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rules in Chapter 252: Rules Governing the Implementation of Hypodermic Apparatus Exchange Programs, no later than October 1, 2021 to permit intranasal naloxone hydrochloride distribution through vending machines in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 1341, subsection 2, paragraph K. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

26 27 28	This bill allows hypodermic apparatus exchange programs and overdose prevention programs to distribute intranasal naloxone hydrochloride through vending machines in accordance with rules adopted by the Department of Health and Human Services.
