Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §170-C is enacted to read:
§170-C. Required training regarding media literacy
All Legislators and legislative staff shall attend and complete a course of in-person education and training on media literacy at the beginning of each regular session of the Legislature. The Legislative Council shall develop and implement this course of education and training to assist Legislators and legislative staff to recognize disinformation and misinformation.
SUMMARY
This bill requires the Legislative Council to provide training to all Legislators and legislative staff, at the beginning of each regular session of the Legislature, on media literacy. The purpose of the training is to help Legislators and legislative staff recognize disinformation and misinformation.
