8 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 902,
9 L.D. 1231, "An Act Concerning Climate and Community Investment Projects"

10 Amend the amendment in section 1 in c. 47 in §3701 in subsection 1 by striking out all
11 of paragraph B (page 1, lines 22 to 31 in amendment) and inserting the following:

12 'B. "Assisted project" means a construction project:

13 (1) To construct a source of electrical generation of 2 megawatts or more that
14 involves a renewable energy project, an energy efficiency project or a project for
15 the production of energy for which the generator is entitled to participate in the net
16 energy billing program in Title 35-A, chapter 32 or is a related construction project;
17 and

18 (2) For which the State or an agency of the State provides economic assistance,
19 including but not limited to payments pursuant to power purchase agreements,
20 certifications that entitle the generator to renewable energy credits, rebates, grants,
21 loans, commitments of funds or tax abatements or tax exemptions or other
22 assistance, if the financial value of the economic assistance is at least \$50,000.'

23 Amend the amendment in section 1 in c. 47 in §3701 by inserting after subsection 5
24 the following:

25 '6. Application. This section does not apply to a project:

26 A. For which the Public Utilities Commission approved a term sheet or contract or
27 otherwise provided project-specific authorization or approval pursuant to Title 35-A
28 on or before June 29, 2021; or

29 B. Participating in net energy billing that meets the requirements of Title 35-A, section
30 3209-A, subsection 7.'

31 Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

32 'Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022.'

33 Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
34 section number to read consecutively.


SENATE AMENDMENT

R.O.F.S

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SUMMARY

This amendment amends the definition of "assisted project" to clarify that an assisted project is a construction project to construct a source of electrical generation of 2 megawatts or more and for which at least \$50,000 in state assistance is provided. The amendment excludes certain projects from the provisions in the committee amendment concerning climate and community investment projects. The amendment adds an effective date of January 1, 2022.
