1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §10015** is enacted to read:

3 **§10015. Charges limited**

4 A postsecondary educational institution that receives any state or federal funds may
5 not charge a student more than \$40,000 for a bachelor's degree or other 4-year degree.

7 This bill provides that a postsecondary educational institution that receives any state or
8 federal funds may not charge a student more than \$40,000 for a bachelor's degree or other
9 4-year degree.
