COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 920, L.D. 1254, "An Act Shielding Fire Departments That Install Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors from Liability"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §173 in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the first line (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "capacity" the following: 'and authorized by the municipal officers'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the immunity from liability for fire departments in the bill applies if the installation or delivery of smoke or carbon monoxide detectors is authorized by the municipal officers.
