For the purposes of this section, "mandatory term of imprisonment" includes a required minimum term of imprisonment, as well as a term in which some or all of the term of imprisonment may not be suspended. The Revisor of Statutes shall submit a report by January 15, 2022 to the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety listing all provisions of all Titles of the Maine Revised Statutes that require the court to impose a mandatory term of imprisonment. After receiving and reviewing the report of the Revisor of Statutes, the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety may introduce legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 130th Legislature.
