1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2936** is enacted to read:

3 **§2936. Social workers at public safety answering points**

4 A public safety answering point shall have on staff on a 24-hour basis a person licensed  
5 under Title 32, chapter 83 to screen 9-1-1 calls to determine whether a 9-1-1 call requires  
6 dispatch of social work services, listed under Title 32, section 7053-A, or other emergency  
7 services.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill requires public safety answering points receiving 9-1-1 calls to have on staff  
10 on a 24-hour basis a licensed social worker to screen 9-1-1 calls to determine whether a  
11 9-1-1 call requires dispatch of social work services or other emergency or law enforcement  
12 services.
