HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 979,
L.D. 1327, "An Act To Create the Maine Health Care Provider Loan Repayment Program"

Amend the amendment by inserting after subsection 4 the following:

'Amend the bill in section 2 in c. 441 in §12951 by inserting after subsection 4 the following:

'5. Health care provider. "Health care provider" means a person licensed or certified by this State as a medical, dental or behavioral health practitioner and performing within the scope of the person's practice as defined by state law or a person with a professionally recognized medical, dental or behavioral health credential.'

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in section 2 in c. 441 in §12953 in subsection 1 in the 3rd to 7th lines (page 1, line 37 and page 2, lines 1 to 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "money received from 25% of the proceeds from the renewal of the contract for the operations of the State's wholesale spirits business under Title 28-A, section 90; existing funding for other authority programs that may, at the discretion of the authority, be combined with the program; and appropriations, allocations and contributions from private and public sources" and inserting the following: 'any funds appropriated, allocated or contributed from private or public sources, including from state and federal sources, and any existing funding for authority programs that, at the discretion of the authority, may be combined with the program'

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 3rd indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in section 2 in c. 441 in §12953 in subsection 2 in the last line (page 2, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "chapter" the following: ' , except for federal funds that must be expended according to guidelines issued by the Federal Government governing the use of those funds'

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 6th indented paragraph after the title the following:

21 shall open the application cycle by February 1st of each year" and inserting the following:

SUMMARY

This amendment does the following:

1. Adds a definition of "health care provider";
2. Removes the funding provisions related to the proceeds from the renewal of the contract for the operations of the State's wholesale spirits business under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28-A, section 90 and allows for funding appropriated or allocated from state and federal sources;
3. Removes the eligibility requirement that an applicant not be a current recipient of a state-funded student loan;
4. Reduces the program duration from 5 years to 3 years and adjusts the total amount that may be awarded accordingly;
5. Requires the Finance Authority of Maine to publicize the dates and deadlines of the application cycle for the program using a method determined by the authority; and
6. Adds an appropriations and allocations section.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the funding from the Liquor Operation Revenue Fund. As amended, the bill will not have an impact on the Maine Budget Stabilization Fund or the distribution of anticipated liquor revenue.

This amendment includes ongoing Other Special Revenue Funds and Federal Expenditures Fund base allocations of \$500 per year beginning in fiscal year 2021-22 to a newly created Maine Healthcare Provider Loan Repayment Program Fund within the Finance Authority of Maine (FAME) to authorize the expenditure of funds received from public, private or federal sources for the repayment of student loans for eligible health care providers and to pay the costs to FAME for administering the fund.
