Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill provides a sales tax exemption on gold and silver transactions and will result in a reduction in General Fund revenue of \$264,687 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$539,962 in fiscal year 2022-23. It will also result in a reduction in Local Government Fund revenue of \$10,313 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$21,038 in fiscal year 2022-23.
