1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §8238, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 2019, c. 655, §4, is repealed.
3 4	Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §15683-B, sub-§9, as enacted by PL 2015, c. 54, §6, is amended to read:
5 6 7 8	9. Phase-in procedures for new or newly expanded public charter schools or other schools. For new or newly expanded public charter schools, or any schools funded under the charter school model, the commissioner shall make a preliminary calculation of total allocation based on the following:
9 10	A. Estimated student counts not to exceed the enrollment limit established by the Maine Charter School Commission;
11	B. Estimated rates and weights based on statewide averages; and
12 13 14 15 16	C. The preliminary calculation of total allocation, which must be replaced with actual student data once students have been enrolled for the new school year. The new or newly expanded public charter school or other school funded under the charter school model shall enroll new students no later than August 1st in a student information system maintained by the department.
17	SUMMARY
18 19 20 21 22	This bill repeals the provision of law that terminates the powers, duties and authority of the Maine School for Marine Science, Technology, Transportation and Engineering 90 days after the adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 130th Legislature. The bill also provides that the phase-in procedures for schools that are funded in the same way as charter schools are the same as those for charter schools.
