Sec. 1. Recreational Trails Program and transportation alternatives set-aside as part of the surface transportation block grant program obligation. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation may not obligate less than 95% of the annual federal apportionment for the Recreational Trails Program, established under 23 United States Code, Section 133 and Section 206, and the transportation alternatives set-aside portion of the surface transportation block grant program within Section 1109 of the federal Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act, 23 United States Code, Section 133(h), to those programs.

9 SUMMARY

 This resolve directs the Department of Transportation to obligate not less than 95% of the annual federal apportionment for the Recreational Trails Program and the transportation alternatives set-aside from the surface transportation block grant program to those programs.
