2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1261 is enacted to read:
3	§1261. Obstructive sleep apnea
4 5 6 7	The Secretary of State may not refuse to issue, refuse to renew or suspend a Class C license for the medical reason of obstructive sleep apnea, including because the applicant or holder is nonresponsive or nonadherent to sleep apnea therapy, if the applicant or holder does not have:
8	1. History. A history of falling asleep while driving;
9 10 11	 Recorded accident. A recorded accident or near miss caused by excessive drowsiness; or Traffic violation. A traffic violation caused by excessive drowsiness.
12	SUMMARY
13 14 15 16 17	This bill prohibits the Secretary of State from refusing to issue, refusing to renew or suspending a Class C driver's license for the medical reason of obstructive sleep apnea, including because the applicant or holder is nonresponsive or nonadherent to sleep apnea therapy, if the applicant or holder does not have a history of falling asleep while driving, a recorded accident or a near miss caused by excessive drowsiness or a traffic violation caused by excessive drowsiness.
