1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, this Act concerns the well-being of students participating in school athletic 4 programs and activities; and 5 Whereas, schools may reopen or conduct athletic programs or activities before 90 days after adjournment of the First Regular Session of the 130th Legislature; and 6 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 8 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 9 therefore, 10 11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13 is enacted to read: 12 13 §13. Biological males' participation in female athletic programs and activities at schools that receive federal funding 14 A school administrative unit or an elementary school, secondary school or 15 16 postsecondary educational institution in the State that receives any federal funding shall prohibit a person whose biological sex at birth is male from participating in an athletic 17 program or activity that is designated for females. 18 19 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved. 20 21 **SUMMARY** 22 This bill directs a school administrative unit or an elementary school, secondary school 23 or postsecondary educational institution in the State that receives any federal funding to 24 prohibit a person whose biological sex at birth is male from participating in an athletic 25 program or activity that is designated for females.
