Refrain from joining or participating in the activities of organizations for the purposes of representation and collective bargaining, except that an 26 27 employee may be required to pay to the organization that is the bargaining agent for the employee a service fee that represents the employee's pro rata share of those expenditures 28 29 that are germane to the organization's representational activities. 30 SUMMARY 31 This bill removes the authority to require public employees who do not join a union to 32 pay service fees to the union.
