Reproduced and distributed under the direction of the Secretary of the Senate. **STATE OF MAINE SENATE 130TH LEGISLATURE** SECOND REGULAR SESSION COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 455, L.D. 1406, "An Act To Encourage Relocation to Rural Maine" Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following: 'An Act To Encourage the Relocation of Persons from outside the State to Rural Maine' Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following: 'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §13056-J is enacted to read: §13056-J. Rural broadband assistance grant program The department shall establish a program under which a regional community and economic development organization, as described in section 13072, subsection 2, that serves an area located in a rural region of the State may provide a grant to cover the cost of obtaining broadband services for up to 5 years to an individual who has moved to a rural region of the State served by the regional community and economic development organization from a location outside of the State within the 12 months preceding the date of application for the grant. A grant made under this section may not exceed \$1,000 per year. For the purposes of this section, "rural region of the State" has the same meaning as in section 13056-I. The department may establish routine technical rules pursuant to chapter 375, subchapter 2-A to implement this section. Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made. 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### SUMMARY

11 This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires the Department of 12 Economic and Community Development to establish a program under which a regional community and economic development organization that serves an area located in a rural 13 14 region of the State, Aroostook, Piscataquis, Somerset and Washington counties, may provide a grant to cover the cost of obtaining broadband services for up to 5 years to an 15 16 individual who has moved to a rural region of the State served by the regional community 17 and economic development organization from a location outside of the State within the 12 months preceding application for the grant. A grant made under this program may not 18 19 exceed \$1,000 per year.

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$100,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2022-23 to the Business Development program within the Department of Economic and Community Development to provide funds to regional community and economic development organizations that serve rural regions of the State for the purpose of providing grants of up to \$1,000 per year to individuals who have moved into a rural region of the State from outside of the State to cover the cost of obtaining broadband services in a rural area for up to 5 years.
