Educational outcome database 18 No later than January 1, 2022, and biennially thereafter, the Department of Labor, in 19 consultation with the Department of Education and the task force, shall update the database. 20 State Education and Employment Outcomes Task Force Sec. 2. 21 appointments. All appointments to the State Education and Employment Outcomes Task 22 Force pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 12901 must be made no 23 later than 30 days following the effective date of this Act. The appointing authorities shall 24 notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council once all appointments have been 25 completed. After appointment of all members, the chairs shall call and convene the first 26 meeting of the task force. If 30 days or more after the effective date of this Act a majority 27 of but not all appointments have been made, the chairs may request authority and the 28 Legislative Council may grant authority for the task force to meet and conduct its business. 29

the database with additional data regarding vocational schools, student loan information, financial aid awards and student loan default rates, incorporation of data available in other publicly available state or national databases, best practices from other states and any other information that would inform a prospective student. The task force shall report to the joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs and labor and housing matters no later than November 1, 2022. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs may report out a bill related to the report to the First Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes and replaces the bill and requires the Department of Labor, in consultation with the Department of Education and the State Education and Employment Outcomes Task Force, to update the educational outcome database established pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 12901, also known as the MaineEARNS database, no later than January 1, 2022, and biennially thereafter. The amendment also requires that appointments to the State Education and Employment Outcomes Task Force pursuant to Title 20-A, section 12901 be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this legislation. The task force is directed to study the updating of, and improvements to, the MaineEARNS database. The task force must report to the joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs and labor and housing matters no later than November 1, 2022. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs may report out a bill related to the report to the First Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.
