SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 467,
L.D. 1417, "An Act Regarding Campaign Finance Reform"

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Amend the amendment in section 5 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the 5th line (page
2, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "a legislative" and inserting the
following: 'that'

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Amend the amendment by inserting after section 12 the following:

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'Sec. 13. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2023.'

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Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment provides that a party committee, a leadership political action
committee, a separate segregated fund committee, a caucus political action committee and
any other political action committee may make contributions to a candidate that do not
exceed the amount that an individual may contribute to that candidate. The amendment
also provides that the effective date of this legislation is January 1, 2023.

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
