SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1055,  
L.D. 1439, "An Act To Clarify All-terrain Vehicle Registration Requirements and  
Establish Regular Maintenance of Designated State-approved All-terrain Vehicle Trails"

Amend the amendment in section 8 in subsection 5-B in the 7th line (page 2, line 7 in  
amendment) by striking out the following: "2,000" and inserting the following: "2,400"

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the definition of "oversized ATV" to increase the weight  
from 2,000 pounds to 2,400 pounds.
