COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "To H.P. 1064, L.D. 1448, "An Act To Increase
State Reimbursement to Municipalities for Revenue Lost Due to the Homestead Property
Tax Exemption"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Increase the Homestead Property Tax Exemption'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §683, sub-§1-B, as amended by PL 2019, c. 343, Pt. H, §2, is further amended to read:

1-B. Additional exemption. A homestead eligible for an exemption under subsection 1 is eligible for an additional exemption of \$5,000 of the just value of the homestead for property tax years beginning on April 1, 2016, \$10,000 of the just value of the homestead for property tax years beginning on April 1, 2017, April 1, 2018 and April 1, 2019 and, \$15,000 of the just value of the homestead for property tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2020 and April 1, 2021 and \$20,000 of the just value of the homestead for property tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2022.
