COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1086, L.D. 1470, "Resolve, Regarding Reimbursement for Providing Inpatient Care to Individuals with Acute Mental Health Care Needs"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "January 1, 2021." and inserting the following: 'October 1, 2021. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

Amend the resolve by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.
