COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 475, L.D. 1472, "An Act To Require Legislative Approval for the State's Participation in Compacts, Programs and Agreements Regarding Transportation and Climate Change"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Require Legislative Approval for the State's Participation in Compacts and Agreements Regarding Transportation and Climate Change'**

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1504 in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "programs"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1504 in the first indented paragraph in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 5 and 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "program"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, removes programs from the purview of the legislation.

## Fiscal Note

### Legislative Cost/Study

#### Legislative Cost/Study

The Legislature's baseline budget for 2022-2023 includes funds for the Legislature to meet during the legislative session and to meet in special session on 2 days each fiscal year following the applicable statutory deadline. If the Legislature is required to convene in special session for the purpose stated in the bill, whether or not there are sufficient funds to cover the cost of holding a special session will depend on the number of times the Legislature is required to convene in special session during the interim.
