SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1102,
L.D. 1488, "Resolve, To Study and Recommend Improvements to Maine's Dam Safety"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 12 and 13 in amendment) by striking out the following: ", to the extent funds are available,"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "June 1, 2022" and inserting the following: 'September 30, 2023'

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 18 in amendment) by striking out the following: "June 1, 2022 and to the extent funds are available" and inserting the following: 'September 30, 2023'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 29 in amendment) by striking out the following: "June 1, 2022, by January 1, 2023" and inserting the following: 'September 30, 2023, by January 1, 2024'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in the 2nd to last line (page 1, line 34 in amendment) by striking out the following: "First" and inserting the following: 'Second'

Amend the amendment in section 4 in the first line (page 2, line 1 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "That" the following: ', in addition to the funds provided in this legislation,'

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.


