SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1146, L.D. 1541, "An Act To Support and Improve Municipal Recycling Programs and Save Taxpayer Money"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in §2146 in subsection 13 in paragraph E in the first line (page 17, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2024" and inserting the following: '2025'

Amend the amendment in section 2 in §2146 in subsection 13 in paragraph E in subparagraph (2) in the first line (page 17, line 40 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2027" and inserting the following: '2028'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in the 2nd line (page 18, line 20 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2022" and inserting the following: '2023'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting the following:

**Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.


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SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1146, L.D. 1541 (S-382)

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**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the appropriations for fiscal year 2021-22 and changes the date from December 31, 2022 to December 31, 2023 by which the Department of Environmental Protection must initiate rulemaking. It also changes by one year the dates by which the department must begin submitting reports to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over environmental and natural resources matters.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment delays the start and moves the fiscal year 2021-22 appropriations to fiscal year 2022-23, shifts the rule-making requirement from December 31, 2022 to December 31, 2023 and delays required reporting deadlines by one calendar year. The Other Special Revenue Funds allocations and revenue are backed out from fiscal year 2024-25 and moved to fiscal year 2025-26. As amended, the bill still has a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Environmental Protection of \$131,292 in fiscal year 2022-23.
