Resolved: That the Maine Arts Commission shall create a program to provide public art recovery grants. The sources of funds for the program are any funds derived from the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 that are eligible for the purposes of the program. The purpose of the program is to provide grants to public entities within the State, including, but not limited to, public postsecondary institutions, kindergarten to grade 12 schools, libraries, municipalities and state and local governmental agencies that apply for funds for the installation of art or for the performance of art that is publicly accessible. For the purposes of the program, "art" must be construed broadly and may include, but is not limited to, a mural, sculpture, painting, audio or visual presentation, digital presentation, musical or theatrical performance, demonstration of or instruction in an activity or performing a task or a lecture. A recipient of a grant under this section shall contract or commission a provider, maker or performer of the public art that resides or is located in the State and is registered for the program with the Maine Arts Commission.'

This legislation requires the Maine Arts Commission to create a program to provide public art recovery grants to public entities in the State utilizing funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) if these funds are eligible to be used for this purpose and any funds appropriated by the State. It is assumed that if no ARPA funds are allowed to be used, no grants will be provided.
