2	Sec. 1. 19-A MRSA §1653, sub-§15 is enacted to read:
3 4	15. Enforcement by law enforcement. Upon request of a parent, a law enforcement agency shall enforce an order granted under subsection 2, paragraph D, subparagraph (1).
5	SUMMARY
6 7	This bill requires that upon a request of a parent, a law enforcement agency must enforce a child custody order, including a visitation order, issued by a court.
