1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 19-A MRS §1653, sub-§15** is enacted to read:

3 **15. Enforcement by law enforcement.** Upon request of a parent, a law enforcement
4 agency shall enforce an order granted under subsection 2, paragraph D, subparagraph (1).

5 **SUMMARY**

6 This bill requires that upon a request of a parent, a law enforcement agency must
7 enforce a child custody order, including a visitation order, issued by a court.
