SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 492, L.D. 1581, "An Act To Require Telecommunications Companies To Divulge Location Information to Law Enforcement When Necessary To Respond to a 9-1-1 Call or Locate a Person in Danger"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 5th line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: ", and the possessor of the location information" and inserting the following: ', and the possessor of the location information'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 7th line (page 1, line 24 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "delay" the following: 'does not believe the request is made in bad faith'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

#### SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to provide that, when imminent danger of death or serious physical injury is present, the possessor of the location information must provide the information to the governmental requester as long as the possessor of the location information does not believe the request is made in bad faith.
