COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "ff" to S.P. 508, L.D. 1584, "An Act To Make Donated Medicines Available to Maine Patients at an Affordable Cost"

Amend the bill in section 3 in c. 606 in §2700-B in subsection 5 in the first line (page 3, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "person, including, but not limited to, any individual."

Amend the bill in section 3 in c. 606 in §2700-B in subsection 5 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "pharmacy." and inserting the following: 'pharmacy or'

Amend the bill in section 3 in c. 606 in §2700-B in subsection 5 in the 3rd line (page 3, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2700." and inserting the following: '2700'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 4.

Amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision establishing a state income tax credit for donating to the Medicine Donation and Redispensing Program. The amendment also removes the authorization for an individual to donate to the program and restricts the authority to donate to manufacturers, licensed health care professionals, pharmacies, licensed health care facilities and the Unused Pharmaceutical Disposal Program.

The amendment adds an appropriations and allocations section to provide funding for the program.
