SUMMARY 1 2 This amendment removes the provision establishing a state income tax credit for 3 donating to the Medicine Donation and Redispensing Program. The amendment also 4 removes the authorization for an individual to donate to the program and restricts the 5 authority to donate to manufacturers, licensed health care professionals, pharmacies, 6 licensed health care facilities and the Unused Pharmaceutical Disposal Program. 7 The amendment adds an appropriations and allocations section to provide funding for 8 the program.
