19 20	A. Two members of the Senate, including members from each of the 2 parties holding the largest number of seats in the Legislature, appointed by the President of the Senate;
21 22 23	B. Two members of the House of Representatives, including members from each of the 2 parties holding the largest number of seats in the Legislature, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

27	This amendment replaces the bill, which is a concept draft. It changes the manhaulting
28	of the Wall Judia Advisory Commission established under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title
29 30	20-D, section 901 by removing the Commissioner of Labor, adding the Commissioner of
31	Bedforme and Community Development and adding 6 members representing contain
32	interests, to be appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House, increasing the number of members from 15 to 21.
