11	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following
12 13	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do no become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
14 15 16 17	Whereas, it is critically important that this legislation take effect before the expiration of the 90-day period to allow auditoriums, civic auditoriums and performing arts centers to provide off-premises catering of spirits, wine and malt liquor at outdoor events of gatherings during the upcoming summer tourist season; and
18 19 20 21	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now therefore,'
22	Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following:
23 24	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'
25 26	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
27	SUMMARY
28	This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
