3 4	Sec. 5. Number of trustees. The board of trustees of the district is composed of 3 5 trustees; notwithstanding any law to the contrary, 2 of the trustees are alternates, and an
5	alternate may vote only if a quorum has not yet been reached. Trustees must be residents
6 7	and voters of the district.  Sec. 2. P&SL 2009, c. 32, §5-A is enacted to read:
8 9 10 11	Sec. 5-A. Trustees; alternates. The 2 trustees of the district next elected pursuant to section 5 after the effective date of this section are alternate members who may vote only if a quorum has not yet been reached, and the trustees subsequently elected to those positions are alternates.
