- B. A stage theater that has at least one permanent stage for viewing live plays or similar stage productions by members of the general public who attend through the purchase of individual tickets; or
- C. A music venue that has at least one public space for viewing a live concert or musical performance by members of the general public who attend through the purchase of individual tickets, and the majority of income generated by the music venue is derived through such ticket sales;
- 2. Experienced a financial loss as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic that limited the capacity or operations of the movie theater, stage theater or music venue; and
- 3. Has no current state or local tax liens on record from prior to March 15, 2020 related to the movie theater, stage theater or music venue.'

#### SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, replaces the bill with a resolve. The resolve directs the Department of Economic and Community Development to create and administer a program and fund to provide grants to movie and stage theaters and music venues within this State. The funds for the program come from funds available for the purpose of the program in the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. The department is required to follow guidelines from the United States Department of the Treasury for the use of those funds in creating the program. The eligibility criteria in the bill are changed to remove the 30% decline in ticket sales and replace it with a demonstrated financial loss as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. It also adds that an applicant is still eligible if a state or local tax lien on record was applied on or after March 15, 2020. The department is required to report to the Joint Standing Committee on Innovation, Development, Economic Advancement and Business by January 15, 2022.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation requires the Department of Economic and Community Development to create a program to provide grants to film and stage theaters and music venues within the State that meet certain eligibilty requirements utilizing funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) if these funds are eligible to be used for this purpose. It is assumed that if ARPA funds are not allowed to be used, no grants will be provided.
