COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 529, L.D. 1644, "An Act To Improve the Disability Retirement Program of the Maine Public Employees Retirement System"

Amend the bill in section 18 in §17106-B in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 4, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or" and inserting the following:

Amend the bill in section 18 in §17106-B in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 4, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "provider" the following: 'or any individual'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies that a person applying for disability retirement benefits may have a representative of their choice present at an independent medical examination required by the executive director.
