COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1252, L.D. 1683, "Resolve, To Compensate Department of Corrections Employees for Hazardous Work"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, To Compensate Certain Department of Corrections Employees and Department of Health and Human Services Employees for Hazardous Work'

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "pandemic" the following: 'under a signed agreement between a labor union representing those employees and the Department of Corrections'

Amend the resolve by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Department of Health and Human Services hazard duty stipend.

Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services, and any entity providing services on behalf of the department, shall compensate employees employed at the Dorothea Dix Psychiatric Center and the Riverview Psychiatric Center who are eligible for a hazard duty stipend related to the COVID-19 pandemic under a signed agreement between a labor union representing those employees and the Department of Health and Human Services. The stipend must:

1. Be paid retroactively from the time the previous hazard duty stipend was removed;
2. Continue until the state of civil emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic is terminated; and
3. Be contingent upon the State's receiving COVID-19 pandemic relief funding from the Federal Government for which the hazard duty stipend for the Department of Health and Human Services could be a qualifying expense.

Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.

26 **SUMMARY**

27 This amendment provides a new title for the resolve. This amendment specifies that
28 the Department of Corrections employees who are eligible for the hazard duty stipend are
29 those employees who were eligible under a signed agreement between a labor union
30 representing those employees and the Department of Corrections. The amendment extends
31 the compensation under the resolve to employees of the Department of Health and Human
32 Services who are employed at the Dorothea Dix Psychiatric Center and the Riverview
33 Psychiatric Center who are eligible for a hazard duty stipend related to the COVID-19
34 pandemic under a signed agreement between a labor union representing those employees
35 and the Department of Health and Human Services.

36 The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes one-time Federal Expenditures Fund - ARP State Fiscal Recovery allocations of \$21,470,430 in fiscal year 2021-22. This total includes allocations of \$14,720,430 to the Department of Corrections and allocations of \$6,750,000 to the Department of Health and Human Services for hazard pay for certain staff in Correctional Facilities, the Dorothea Dix Psychiatric Center and the Riverview Psychiatric Center. The estimated amount of allocations needed assumes hazard pay will be retroactive to January 1, 2021 and paid through the end of fiscal year 2022. The availability of the Federal Expenditures Fund - ARP State Fiscal Recovery funding for this purpose will depend on other amounts allocated from this Fund by the Legislature.
